Joint Implementation is the flexible mechanism for the capped environment. Project developers of JI projects, grouped in the JI Action Group (JIAG), see much potential for future development. The general perception is that JI is only relevant in economies in transition whereas the market sees increasing JI activity in other Annex-I countries. After 2012 the capped environment may increase, creating unprecedented opportunities for JI.

At the side event the presentations will focus on how the geographical and sectoral scope of JI can be expanded and how different options can be elaborated in the post-2012 negotiations.
